Hi Debbie,

I left you a voicemail message and thought I would follow up with an e-mail message. I couldn't remember when the comment period expired, I thought it was the early part of April.

Anyway, I noticed only two minor things that possibly should be changed: on page 6 – the last sentence of 3.1 Community History, where it states: home of the U.S. Strategic Command (SAC) – I believe that should be: the U.S. Strategic Air Command (SAC). (I used to work there)

On page 8 under Other stakeholders that have been involved with the Site include the following groups or agencies: the third one listed is: Indian Chicano Health Center – they used to be called that, but they are now called One World Community Health Center.

They used to serve the Indian community, but it is mostly Hispanics now. They may say they are open to everyone, but the Indians have a medical clinic in Omaha now, it is called the Fred LeRoy Health and Wellness Center (owned & operated by the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska).

Our organization: **Nebraska Urban Indian Health Coalition, Inc.** is a health information/education center and an Inter-Tribal Treatment Center (for alcohol & drug abuse). In addition, we have a medical clinic in Lincoln, NE and that is called the Nebraska Urban Indian Medical Center.

If you can add our organization under Other stakeholders, that would be nice, but if not, that is O.K.

Just want to share with you that when I used to work for the Corps of Engineers that we worked on some projects that involved waterways and CERCLA, just so you know that I am somewhat

familiar with it, it may help down the road. Also, that I worked for the federal government for 31 years.

I hope this information will be of some help to you.

It was nice meeting you at the community meeting, you did a great job, and I look forward to working with you in the future.
