3.3 Local Government Structures

- The Community Involvement Plan states that there are 33 neighborhood associations in Omaha. According to the City of Omaha website on Neighborhoods there are 180 Neighborhood Associations. Please verify the correct number of Omaha Neighborhood Associations in Omaha.

2.3 Media Outlets

- Please add the radio station KFAB 1110 to the list of radio stations listeners turn to for news. KFAB 1110 is one of the top two radio stations for local news.

4.2 Ongoing Community Involvement

- Fifth Paragraph – Please state that the EPA's attendance at the Lead Safe Omaha Coalition's meetings has been at the invitation of the Executive Director of the Lead Safe Omaha Coalition.

- Seventh Paragraph, second sentence – Please remove the period (“.”) and comma (“,”) from the middle of the sentence.
