Tanya Cook, Todd Davis, Jonah Deppe, Connie Determan, Nancy Gaarder, Kathy Leinenkugel, Jesús Magaña, Jennifer Rawley, Reid Steinkraus, Marian Todd, Vernon Waldren, and Cheryl Weston met to discuss the draft comprehensive plan for the Omaha Lead Site. Ms. Determan explained that the draft comprehensive plan would remain a working draft, stating that numerous additions and modifications are expected.

The Subcommittee discussed the draft comprehensive plan, suggesting several changes and additions including:

- Adding a glossary of terms;
- Focusing services on the Omaha Lead Site;
- Clarifying that the comprehensive program will be a collaboration of agencies and organizations;
- Clarifying that coordination will occur with the City and County;
- Inserting language stating that entrance into the program will be voluntary, but once in the program, actions (such as soil removals) will not be voluntary, as stipulated by law;
- Adding language describing existing ordinances and laws; and
- Inserting language regarding nutrition.

The Subcommittee agreed to meet again on Wednesday, August 11, 2004. The meeting place and time are to be announced. Subcommittee members agreed to provide thorough comments on the draft plan by the next meeting. Specifically, Subcommittee members agreed to complete the following:

- Tanya Cook will research coordination efforts already taking place;
- Kathy Leinenkugel will provide definitions for a glossary;
- Marian Todd and Reid Steinkraus will research current legal requirements;
- Jonah Deppe will further define current lead services; and
- Vernon Waldren will provide language on nutrition and education.

Several questions were identified by the Subcommittee to be addressed by the CAG, including:

- What should the name of the comprehensive program be?
- Should the comprehensive program be established by an existing group or through a new umbrella organization?
